There is no pre-registration. Just bring in your exhibits and entry form to the Village Hall on the day between 10 and 11.30am. There is no additional fee for competing.

DAFFODILS (supplied vases must be used)

1. Vase of 3 trumpet daffodils
2. Vase of 3 all-yellow daffodils
3. Vase of 3 all-white daffodils
4. Vase of 3 pink trumpet daffodils
5. Vase of 3 bi-colour daffodils (one or more varieties)
6. Vase of 3 double daffodils
7. Vase of 5 miniature daffodils
8. Vase of 5 daffodils (one or more varieties)
9. Container of growing daffodils (one or more varieties)

NARCISSI (supplied vases must be used)

10. Vase of 3 pheasant-eyed narcissi
11. Vase of 3 multi-headed narcissi (one or more varieties)

TULIPS

12. Vase of 5 tulips (one or more varieties) (**supplied vases must be used**)
13. Your own container of growing tulips (one or more varieties)

SPRING FLOWERS (where vases or containers are specified, please use your own)

14. Vase of 5 or more mixed bulb flowers (*all to be in flower*)
15. Container of growing spring flowers and foliage
16. 3 hellebore blooms floating in a container (one or more varieties)
17. Bloom of any variety displayed in a bottle
18. Vase of 5 stems of flowering shrubs (one or more varieties)
19. Vase of 1 stem of a scented shrub
20. Vase of 1 spray of a flowering clematis (*with foliage*)
21. Vase of 3 stems of blossom from an ornamental or orchard tree (one or more varieties).

22. Container of growing heathers (*single or mixed varieties*)
23. 3 camellia blooms floating in a container
24. Vase of 3 polyanthus or primula stems
25. 6 pansies or viola blooms (*boxes for display will be provided*)
26. Container of growing violas and/or pansies (*no size restrictions*)

HOUSEPLANTS

27. 1 Flowering houseplant
28. 1 Foliage house plant
29. 1 Cactus or succulent in a pot (*no size restrictions*)
30. 1 Auricula in a pot
31. 1 Pot of amaryllis

FLOWER ARRANGING

32. A petite arrangement using flowers from your garden (*not more than 23cm/9" overall*)
33. An arrangement in a mug (*no size restrictions*)

NOTES FOR EXHIBITORS

The Ilmington Horticultural Society's objective is to encourage community gardening and our shows offer an opportunity for friendly competition. These are not shows for professional horticulturalists. Entries will be judged on their merit on the day and prizes awarded accordingly.

The show is open to all, residents and non-residents of Ilmington.

Admission to the Show for exhibitors and visitors is £1 (free if 16 and under).

There are no additional charges for entries.

Exhibits are to be staged on the morning of the show 10-11.30am. Regulation vases for cut material will be supplied as marked on the schedule.

Please avoid using Oasis in flower arrangements.

Only one exhibit per entrant per class.

Wrongly placed exhibits are the responsibility of the entrant.

The Hall must be cleared for judging by 11.30am.

Prizegiving will take place at 3.45pm. The Gardner Cup will be awarded to the best exhibit in the Show with a prize for the Most Points achieved by a single exhibitor.

No exhibit to be removed before 4pm.
