

Ilmington Pavilion Code of Conduct

The pavilion is a shared facility used by a number of sports clubs, community groups, and other hirers. We ask everyone to be considerate of other users and to help make the pavilion a pleasant and respectful place for all.

Please:

- Respect other users and their activities. Do not enter or use a room which has been hired or allocated to another group without their permission.
- Use the appropriate access to the changing rooms. The club room should not be used as a route to or from the changing rooms where an alternative access is available.
- Respect people's privacy and dignity. When changing rooms are in use, doors should be kept appropriately closed so that people who are changing or undressed are not visible from communal areas or other rooms.
- Keep noise to a reasonable level, particularly around changing rooms and rooms being used by other clubs.
- Leave shared areas clean and tidy for the next users.
- Treat the pavilion and other clubs' equipment and belongings with care.
- Be courteous when clubs are changing over, allowing the incoming and outgoing groups to use the facilities without unnecessary disruption.
- Ensure that your members, spectators and guests also follow these simple principles.

Remember: The pavilion is a shared facility. A little consideration for others helps everyone to enjoy using it.

Before leaving the pavilion, users should ensure that:

- The areas used are clean and tidy.
- Lights and kitchen appliances are switched off.
- Doors are closed and the building is secure.
- All rubbish and personal belongings are removed and taken away with you.
